Every year we read horror stories about children who get into serious trouble because of people they have *met* online— let's work together to make sure this *never* happens to a child from Coates Lane.

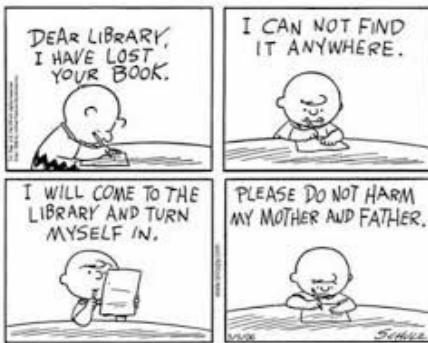


Keep your identity hidden online like the children of Class 5 who developed their own emoji-avatars.
