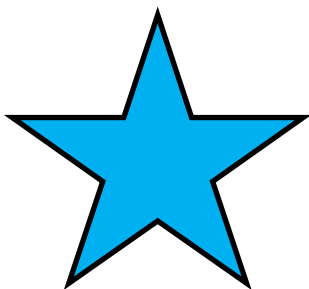
Thank you to all the parents who support us in our shared journey in your child's education. I hope you all have a fantastic summer break and enjoy some quality family time.
