

Year 2 - Week Commencing 11.9.17

Maths

We will be learning about how numbers can be represented in different ways (using drawings for base 10, using number lines and coins). We will be problem solving using our learning of place value and we will be counting in steps of 2, 3, 5 and 10.

English

We will continue to learning about stories with a familiar setting, using Katie Morag as our shared text. We will be looking at the structure of a narrative story (a beginning, build-up, problem, resolution and an ending), and we will then use this to begin planning our own story. We will also continue to look at characters and be using lots of drama to get into character roles and to help us remember the story sequence.

Theme

We will be continuing with our topic 'The place where I live.' This week we will be learning about the history of our school and town and thinking about where we can find the answers to some of the questions we want to find out. We will be learning about the different sounds in our environment in music and because it is Roald Dahl's birthday this week, we will be celebrating by having a Roald Dahl birthday celebration afternoon on Wednesday.
