Maths

This week we will be looking at the following:

Rounding numbers

Place value of decimals

Ordering and comparing decimals

Multiplying and dividing by 10, 100, 1000

Negative numbers

English

We will continue reading the class novel *Running Wild*. We will also look at an extract from *Gold of the Gods* by Bear Grylls. The children will be looking for elements that 'hook' the reader in and will be making predictions based on what is stated and what is implied. We will then move onto unpicking what is including in suspense writing, with the children using the toolkit that they have created to have a go at writing their own suspense paragraph.

In grammar we will be focusing on sentence structure and selecting and generating adverbs.

Theme

We will continue the geography unit that we have started by learning about longitude and latitude. The children will be locating places on maps and using co-ordinates. We will then move onto looking and the difference between human and physical geography, locating key famous sights in the world.
