Maths

This week the children will be focussing on length and perimeter. The children will be developing their skills of estimating, comparing and converting lengths. Further on in the week they will be reinforcing their knowledge of finding the perimeter of regular and irregular shapes.

English

We will be concluding our unit on Fantasy stories. The children will be using all they have learned from *The Firework Makers Daughter* to write their own fantasy stories. I can't wait to read their stories and publish them in our first Year 4 book!

Theme

Mrs Morgan will be continuing her great work in Science and the children will be given several challenges.
