

## Year 6 - Week Commencing 6<sup>th</sup> November 2017

### Maths

This week we will be looking at the following:

Identifying and measuring angles.

Accurately drawing 2d shapes.

Using knowledge of the properties of triangles to help calculate the missing angle.

Naming and classifying quadrilateral and investigating diagonals.

Using knowledge of the properties of quadrilaterals to help calculate the missing angle.

### English

We will be starting to read the classic novel, Mary Poppins by P.L Travers. During English lessons the children will complete a range of reading tasks linked to this. We will also be comparing the book to the film version, identifying similarities and differences. We will also be looking at an extract from Oliver, where the focus will be reading classic fiction out loud using intonation and expression.

In grammar sessions we will be looking at using complex sentences with 'ing' and 'ed' openers. We then move onto looking at prepositions.

### Theme

Science – We be looking at how animals are adapted to survive in the habitats that they live in. The children will be start the process of creating an information page about animal of their choice, detailing how it adapts in order to survive.
