

Year 5 - Week Commencing 29th January 2018

Maths:

This week we're looking at Geometry (Shape, Reflection and Translation).

Our main learning will be to:

- Distinguish between regular and irregular polygons.
- Describe positions on the first quadrant of a coordinate grid.
- Plot specified points and complete shapes.
- Identify, describe and represent the position of a shape following a reflection or translation,

English:

Having planned their own Sci-Fi stories last week, the children will this week create their own version of the Aquila story.

Theme

We will continue to use our computing skills to gather, sort and display interesting facts about the solar system.

The children will be producing more solar system inspired art with Mrs. Mackie and, in music, they will be learning to listen with attention to a range of high quality live and recorded music, using the work of John Williams, which will be instantly recognisable to many children who have seen, Harry Potter, Star Wars, Superman or Indiana Jones movies.
