Maths This week we will be looking at the following:

- Identifying two step rules, using formula to express this.
- Substituting values into algebraic expressions and find particular values.
- Using a given formula to solve problems.
- Reading and plotting co-ordinates in all four quadrants.

On Friday the test will be based on multiplying whole numbers by multiples of ten. As sheet will be sent home to practise this.

English

I have been really impressed with the WW2 writing that the children completed last week and I can't wait to see what they will produce this week.

This week the children will be completing an independent write that will be used for assessment purposes. The children do not complete a SAT test for writing, instead their writing result is based on a range of independent pieces from across the year. They will be writing a WW2 evacuation story, aiming to include a range of writing skills that we have been working on. Once the independent write has been completed, we will move on to looking at letter writing in preparation for the children writing a WW2 evacuation letter.
