

Year 4 - Week Commencing 26-2-18

Maths

This week the children will be further developing their knowledge of place value. We will be identifying the value of each digit in numbers up to 2 sometimes 3 decimal places. The children will be ordering larger sets of numbers by using the mathematical symbols for greater than and less than.

English

This week the children will be concluding our unit based on debates. The children will this week be writing their own debate text on an aspect of hunting and looking at both sides of the argument. We will be publishing these into our own book for you to read at the next parents evening. We will also be filming our new and improved 'LIVE Debate'... watch this space!

Theme

The children will be starting a new theme based on The Great Plague. This topic will be mainly be history based but will try to include all aspects of the curriculum. This is a favourite of mine as it involves lots of independent research using both primary and secondary resources. The children will also get the chance to create their own 'remedy', based on real ones used at the time. (Think 'Georges Marvellous Medicine'!)
