

Year 6 - Week Commencing 26th February 2018

Maths This week we will be looking at the following:

- Solving problems based on enlargement and scale factor.
- Comparing quantities using the language of ratio and proportion.
- Solving problems involving direct proportion by scaling quantities up or down.
- Solving problems involving unequal sharing and grouping.

This week's test will be on calculating with fractions. Adding, subtracting, and multiplying fractions. Multiplying and dividing fractions by whole numbers.

English

This week the children will be writing their own discussion text based on hunting. I have been really impressed with their work so far on this unit. They will be using the vocabulary that they have collected to help them and it will be really important to maintain a formal tone. We will also be looking at how we can use higher-level punctuation and some of the Year 5/6 tricky spellings – please see the sheet that was sent home before the holidays. Like last week, we will be using a text map to learn a discussion text off-by-heart.
