Year 3 - Week Commencing 5th March 2018

Maths

This week we shall be finishing our focus on Fractions and moving onto Measurement - capacity.

Measure, compare, add and subtract volumes and capacities.

Measure, compare, add and subtract masses.

Solve problems involving and measures.

English

This week we will be finishing our Poems on a Theme unit where the children will practice reading with rhythm and expression to eventually extend an original and then perform for the class from memory. We will be moving onto our first English unit as part of our 'Iron Man' theme. The first unit will focus around a Novel as a theme, The Iron Man, written by Ted Hughes. The children will view and listen to opening extracts and scenes from the story and begin to use visualising and 'Role on the Wall' techniques to determine what they think the Iron Man is like. From this, we will begin to gather descriptive language as we move through the story.

Theme

This half term our theme is 'The Iron Man'. In Science, we shall be studying magnets and carrying out fair tests to record the difference in force through different materials. In Music our focus will be on listening and responding to movie trailers using expressive language and musical vocabulary. In Design & Technology, we shall be investigating and evaluating pop up books which use leverages and linkages in the view of designing our own in the next few weeks.
