

Year 6 - Week Commencing 9th April 2018

Maths

This week we will begin maths revision.
We will be looking at the following:

- Decimal numbers
- Factors, multiples and prime numbers
- Pie charts and line graphs
- Area and perimeter
- Graphs and charts

In maths starters will be looking addition and subtraction strategies, multiplying and dividing by 10, 100 and 1000 and equivalent fractions.

English

Before the holidays, the children planned their own mystery story. The basic plot outline involves an object being stolen, a detective being contacted to solve the crime, investigating the crime scene and interviewing suspects. This week they will be writing their story, following teacher modelling. They will be working on effectively describing the crime scene, including clues for the reader to piece together, integrating dialogue for a purpose and using up-levelled vocabulary choices. This week is really important for learning, as next week the children will be writing their own mystery story independently.

SATs

SATs week will take place on the week beginning 14th May. Next week, we will be having a mock SATs week in school to provide the children with the opportunity to experience what the week will be like. This is nothing to worry about and we just ask that the children try their very best, which I am sure they will.
