

Year 6 - Week Commencing 4-9-18

Maths

Our main focus in Maths this week will be looking at the written methods the children use for addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. This is just so we can ease ourselves back into Maths (it's been a while...) before we start our Year 6 units of work next week.

English

This week in English the children will be writing a short narrative story. We will be analysing a short text to identify the 'good' features and then the children will plan a short story of their own which they will be publish on Thursday and Friday. We will begin our first Year 6 English unit on Monday.

Theme

Our main theme this term is 'Survival'. For this we will focus mainly on Science, Geography and Art. This week we will be starting the Science aspect which will focus on Evolution and how the Earth has evolved over the years. We will discuss how and why Dinosaurs died out and how some scientists believed they gradually changed over time and became birds. (I look forward to listening to all the children's views and theories on this!)
