

## Year 6 - Week Commencing 10-9-18

### Maths

Our main focus in Maths this week will be place value and the value of each digit in numbers up to one million. As the week progresses we will be comparing numbers up to ten million as well as refining our knowledge of rounding numbers up to the nearest one hundred thousand.

### English

This week in English the children will be starting our 'survival' unit of work in which the children will be writing their own adventure story. We will be looking at 'Running Wild' by Michael Morpurgo and looking at word choice as well as discussing the story itself.

### Theme

Our main theme this term is 'Survival'. For this we will focus mainly on Science, Geography and Art. This week we will be starting the Science aspect which will focus on Evolution and how the Earth has evolved over the years. We will discuss how and why Dinosaurs died out and how some scientists believed they gradually changed over time and became birds.
