

Year 6 - Week Commencing 17-9-18

Maths

Our main focus in Maths this week will be comparing numbers up to ten million as well as refining our knowledge of rounding numbers up to the nearest one hundred thousand. We will then be looking at multiplying and dividing numbers by 10, 100 and 1000. Ask your child about the 'Power of Ten'!

English

This week in English the children will be continuing our 'survival' unit of work in which the children will be writing their own adventure story. We will be beginning to plan our own adventure story based on what we have read. We will also be 'hammering' the grammar (ask your child about this!)

Theme

Our main theme this term is 'Survival'. For this we will focus mainly on Science, Geography and Art. This week we will be starting the Science aspect which will focus on Evolution and how the Earth has evolved over the years. We will be focussing this week on how we have inherited looks and personality traits from our parents. If possible, could your child bring in photos of their parents so we can compare and look for similarities?
