

Year 5 - Week Commencing 24th September 2018

Maths

This week we will be looking at the following:

Ordering and comparing decimal numbers.

Placing decimal numbers on a number line.

Rounding decimal numbers to the nearest whole and the nearest tenth.

Multiplying and dividing by 10, 100 and 1000.

Whilst working on the above we will be practising developing our explanations linked to maths and problem solving skills.

English

This week we will continue writing a legend story, writing a section at a time. We will be focusing on editing and improving our writing by checking grammar, spelling and punctuation. We will also be working on describing characters effectively and using dialogue. In grammar sessions, we will be looking at using co-ordinating and subordinating conjunctions.

Theme

History - We will be investigating the names of towns and cities that originate from the Anglo Saxon period. We will be look at the original meanings of these place names.

PSHE- We will be continue to explore identify and our school community.

Geography – Mrs Morgan will continue working with the children on the United Kingdom Topic. Mrs Morgan will also be teaching music.
