

## Year 6 - Week Commencing 24-9-18

### Maths

Our main focus in Maths this week will be looking at multiplying and dividing numbers by 10, 100 and 1000. Ask your child about the 'Power of Ten'! We will then look at missing number problems involving addition and multiplication. Later in the week we will be looking at problems involving written multiplication.

### English

This week in English the children will be concluding their 'survival' unit of work in which the children will be writing their own adventure story. We will end the week by editing, improving and publishing our stories. We will also be 'hammering' the grammar (ask your child about this!)

### Theme

Our main theme this term is 'Survival'. For this we will focus mainly on Science, Geography and Art. This week we will be starting the Science aspect which will focus on Evolution and how the Earth has evolved over the years. We will be focussing this week on how we have inherited looks and personality traits from our parents. The children will also be using their knowledge of Adaptation to create their own new species, describing how it adapts to its natural habitat in order to survive.
