

Year 3 - Week Commencing 8th October 2018

Maths

This week we will be focusing on applying our work on addition/subtraction facts to 100 in worded problems. Some children have progressed to using facts to solve problems up to 1000! On Wednesday, we shall be looking at questions from all units met so far (place value, mental calculation and statistics) so that planning may be informed for the remaining weeks in this half term. Following this, we shall be solving addition of two and three digit numbers using columnar written method.

English

WOW!! What a Writing Workshop we had! The children blew us away with their innovated Folk Tales, they showed incredible writing stamina and creativity throughout the week. They were an absolute credit as a class and they displayed such enjoyment each writing session. I don't think there was one child who didn't come in every morning asking when the Writing Workshop session was. This week will see us complete our Folk Tales Big Write - based on 'The Clock Tower' and the introduction to our new English unit, Biographies. Guided Reading sessions occur each day. Miss Palmer will hear your child read once a week. During the remaining four sessions the children will be partaking in different activities around their text (pre-read, follow up, comprehension & free choice.

Theme

This week we will be continuing our theme, 'There's no place like home'. In history we will be locating our home address on a map by finding the street and discussing Street Views of our houses in relation to the local features that are nearby. In Geography our focus is honing in on Barnoldswick, using present and past OS maps to plot change. We will be continuing our RE unit with the next thread of questioning in our grid around 'The Church'
