Maths This week we will be looking at the following:

Rounding numbers to approximate and estimate an answer when adding and subtracting.

Using the inverse to check the accuracy of calculations. We will also be looking at using the inverse when solving number problems.

Solving multi-step addition and subtraction problems.

Mental strategies for addition and subtraction.

English

This week we will be continuing to explore a range of persuasive texts, evaluating how the text appeals to the reader and identifying the features of persuasive writing. The children will be collecting examples of persuasive techniques and vocabulary to use in their own writing. We will be using 'Talk for Writing' to learn a persuasive text off-by-heart. Please ask your child to tell you more 😊

In grammar we will continue to learn about modal verbs, looking at how these can be used in persuasive writing.

Theme
