

## Year 6 - Week Commencing 29-10-18

### Maths

This week we will focus on the following:  
Identifying and measuring angles.  
Accurately drawing 2d shapes.  
Using knowledge of the properties of triangles to help calculate the missing angle.  
Naming and classifying quadrilateral and investigating diagonals.  
Using knowledge of the properties of quadrilaterals to help calculate the missing angle.

### English

This week in English the children will be continuing our unit of work based on Newspapers. The children will be creating their own news broadcast by interviewing characters at the scene and using formal and informal language. The children will then write their own report using reported speech.

### Theme

Science - We be looking at how light appears to travel in straight lines and how we can show this. We will also be investigating natural and artificial light sources and ow shadows are formed. In order to make this as 'hands on' as possible, it would be really helpful if your child could bring in a torch on Wednesday.

The children will have PE on Monday (Rugby outside) and also on Friday with Phil and Marie.

Mrs Morgan will be teaching a music unit this half term about Benjamin Britten.
