

## Year 5 - Week Commencing 19<sup>th</sup> November 2018

**Maths** This week we will be looking at the following:

- Reading and interpreting line graphs.
- Completing reasoning questions linked to reading and interpreting line graphs.
- Drawing line graphs.
- Using a line graph to solve problems.

We will be continuing to work on developing mental strategies for addition and subtraction through this unit.

### **English**

Last week we started reading *The Lion, The Witch and The Wardrobe* by C.S Lewis. We will continue reading this, comparing elements of what we read with the film. As part of the reading phase, the children will be practising locating evidence in the text to support a statement. They will also be stepping into the text as the character Lucy and writing in role. As this unit is focused on stories with a historical setting, we will be investigating what makes a good setting description and will be learning a setting description off-by-heart.

Grammar sessions will focus on expanded noun phrases and using a relative clause at the end of a sentence.

### **Theme**

Science – The Science unit this half term is based on reversible and irreversible changes. This week we will be completing an investigation, looking at what happens when water is added to different solids.

Geography and DT– Mrs Morgan will teach Geography and DT.

PSHE – This week we will continue looking at the theme from Anti-Bullying Week, 'Choose Respect.' We will also be thinking about the range of people that make up our school community.
